

Accommodation

Africa Safari Lake Manyara (comfort tent)

Program of the day: After breakfast and relaxing at Lush Garden Hotel, our safari guide will pick you up around 10:00 AM from the hotel and begin a beautiful journey to Tarangire National Park for a wildlife game drive, with lunch boxes provided. After the game drives, we will drive back to your lodge for relaxation, dinner, and an overnight stay.

Tarangire National Park is renowned for its large elephant herds, scattered Baobab trees, and tree-climbing African Pythons. The park features a variety of landscapes, from seasonal swamps to savannas, with the Tarangire River winding its way through the park—the only source of water for wildlife during the dry season. You may have the chance to see a lion stalking its prey or leopards relaxing in the trees above.

Explore one of Tanzania's most rewarding national parks, a land of big baobab trees, big elephants and big cats. No wonder this ends up being the favorite park in Tanzania for many visitors. Sightings of wildebeest, giraffes, hippos, buffaloes, baboons, vervet monkeys and zebras are also almost guaranteed. Lions are plentiful here – Tarangire is home to one of Tanzania's healthiest lion populations. While you'll have to work a little harder to see a cheetah or leopard, it will only enhance your excitement when you do. You can also look forward to classic safari scenery – savannah plains, river woodlands and rocky hills.

Arusha

Get to know Arusha and you'll understand a little more about local life. It's a fascinating city.

Karatu

In the busy provincial town of Karatu, with its constant stream of passing tourist traffic, the many places to stay mean you can rest from life on the road here. It's big enough to have banks, shops (for both supplies and souvenirs) and a few roadside restaurants where locals eat.

Kon Tiki Serengeti Camp

Program of the day: After breakfast, we will depart for Serengeti National Park for wildlife sightings, carrying lunch boxes with us. We will enjoy lunch at a suitable place inside the park. In the afternoon, we will continue the game drive activity before reaching the camp/ lodge.

Visiting the Unesco World Heritage—listed Serengeti is one of the best things you can do on safari. This is a park filled with some of the biggest populations of wildlife in Africa. Here in the Serengeti, there is a very good chance that you will see lions, leopards, cheetahs, elephants, spotted hyenas, buffaloes, zebras, giraffes, wildebeest and so many other species. The endless horizons of the savannah grasslands are the perfect backdrop for seeing so many animals. And there's no better safari image than the sun setting deep red behind a silhouetted acacia tree deep in the Serengeti.



Activities Day 2

Morning

 This morning we'll be taking you to the next stage of your safari, but you'll also get to enjoy one last game drive along the way.


Accommodation Kon Tiki Serengeti Camp

Tented camp

There's a dining tent, you can hear the night sounds of Africa from your bed, and the night sky is full of stars.

Africa Safari Lake Manyara (comfort tent)

Program of the day: You will wake up early, around 6:30 to 7:30 AM and enjoy a magical half-day game drive in Serengeti National Park before departing to your accommodation in Mto wa Mbu for an overnight stay ready for the next adventure. Your accommodation for the night is near the Ngorongoro Crater. This facilitates easy accessibility of the crater for early morning game drives, which is the best time to see animals, as they are more active than during the rest of the day.

Activities Day 3

Half Day

 You'll be heading down more safari trails in search of animals in Serengeti National Park when we take you on a guided game drive. This is the best thing about many safaris, and you'll hopefully see many animals.

Program of the day: Early morning around 6:00 AM. After breakfast, our safari guide will pick you up and take you to the Ngorongoro Crater for a game drive until noon. After the game drive, you will be transferred to Arusha (arrival time around 2:30 PM) and Kilimanjaro International Airport (arrival time around 3:30 PM to 4:30 PM) for your departure, concluding our safari.

Your first sight of Ngorongoro Crater is likely not one you'll easily forget. As seen from the crater rim, this natural bowl, both vast and intimate, is one of Africa's most beautiful natural features, stretching 19 green kilometers (12 miles) from one side to the other. Down in the crater itself, you'll explore an astonishingly rich, self-contained ecosystem that is protected by high crater walls. Here, lions and hyenas hunt wildebeest and Grant's gazelle within sight of elephants and black rhinos. Your day spent here will reveal a surprising variety of habitats, from the Lereal Forest and salty Lake Magadi to the plains that rise and fall gently all across the valley floor.

This is where your safari in Tanzania will end. We hope that you have had the most fabulous trip and we can't wait to help you plan your next safari.

Early Morning

 Transfer by Road, Karatu to Ngorongoro Crater Transfer time; about 30 minutes

Morning

 Exploring Ngorongoro Crater in the company of an expert guide could make your guided game drive here one of the highlights of your whole safari. Look for lions, black rhinos and spotted hyenas as you drive around the crater floor this morning.
